

HELPFUL HINTS

1. Schedule
 - a. Using the list of ten suggested themes from Salt Lake, decide which month you will focus on each of the ten themes in the upcoming year.
2. Survey the sisters to find out which miniclass topics are most appealing, and who is willing to help with what.
3. Teachers
 - a. Give plenty of advance notice (2-3 weeks).
 - b. Present them with a “miniclass planning guide.”
 - c. List resources from Ensign on back of the miniclass planning guide.
 - d. Pick different teachers each month.
 - e. In any given month, offer a variety of teachers (some single, some married, some students, some working, etc.).
4. Content
 - a. “When applicable, make certain these meetings include classes that help develop skills in parenting and family relations.”
 - b. Each of the ten suggested themes can lend itself to applications for parenting skills and family relations skills. These classes should be offered as well as other classes to provide a balance.
5. Publicity
 - a. Two Sundays before Enrichment, pass out an informational flyer.
 - i. One good idea: make it so that it can be folded in half, addressed, and dropped in the mail to sisters who aren’t in church that Sunday.
 - b. One Sunday before Enrichment, pass out a reminder invitation.
6. Punctuality
 - a. Try offering door prizes!
